Assessor Job Description

The position of Assessor of Referees is of great value to NHSOA. It is meant to help referees develop and enhance their skills so that they can have rewarding careers, and best implement the National Federation and NHIAA's rules and regulations. This will assure that high school players in New Hampshire can have fair and safe soccer experiences; coaches and athletic directors can use the matches as an extension of the classroom; and fans can appreciate the efforts of everyone involved.

Candidate Assessors will:

- Have a minimum of three years of documented assessing experience via another soccer association OR be an NISOA Assessor OR have superior ratings as a NHSOA referee along with the recommendation of at least two current NHSOA Board Members
- Be willing to participate in initial Assessor training
- Be willing to participate in annual Assessor training and program development session(s)
- Complete the application, be selected by and report to the NHSOA Assessment Director
- Other evaluation experience, teaching experience, and/or mentoring experience helpful, but not imperative
